Given the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, particularly taking into consideration the fact that the petitioners are still working as a daily wage employee and that they have put in service for a considerable period of time, let the respondents consider the case of the petitioners for regularization in accordance with the circulars of the State Govt. particularly circular dated 05.03.2008 and any subsequent circular.
4. With the aforesaid direction, the writ petition stands disposed of expecting the respondents to decide the case of the petitioners at the earliest preferably within a period of 4 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
