“10.1 The Hon'ble Court may kindly be pleased to issue a writ quashing the amended provision made under the rule 32 & 81 of the Central Motor Vehicles 1989 vide notification dated 29.12.2016 imposing penalty clause and may be declared void.

10.2 That, during pendency of petition the respondent no. 3 may be directed not to take penalty from the petitioner as per endorsement made on 25.07.2018.
