Hon'ble Smt. Justice Rajani Dubey**Order on Board****23.01.2020**

1. The applicant has filed this first bail application under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail in connection with Crime No. 51/2019 registered at Police Station Samripath, District Balrampur-Ramanujganj (C.G.) for the offence punishable under Section 306 of IPC.
2. Applicant is the husband of the deceased Jasinata Sonwani and the allegation against the present applicant is that after the marriage of the parties the applicant used to hurl abuses and commit mar-peet with the deceased, due to that she committed suicide. Based on that, after completion of investigation, offence has been registered against the applicant and he has been arrested.
3. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that the applicant

has been falsely implicated in the crime in question. He further submits that there is no direct allegation against the present applicant to instigate the deceased to commit suicide. He next added that he is in jail since 25.09.2019 and he is ready to furnish adequate surety and shall abide by all the conditions and directions, which may be imposed by this Hon'ble Court, therefore, he may be released on bail.

4. On the other hand, State counsel opposes the bail application.
5. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the record.
6. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, nature and gravity of the offence, as the applicant is in jail since 25.09.2019 and the trial is likely to take some time, without further commenting on merits of the case, I am inclined to release him on bail.
7. Accordingly, the bail application is allowed.
8. It is directed that the applicant shall be released on bail on executing a personal bond for a sum of Rs. 25,000/- with one surety for the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court for his appearance before the said Court as and when directed.
