Pursuant to the order dated 16.09.2019 whereby the petitioner was granted two weeks' time to remove the default which was an peremptory order. Subsequently, the writ petition stood dismissed vide the order dated 03.10.2019 as the default could not be removed within the stipulated time. Learned Counsel for the petitioner would submit that he may be granted two weeks' time as a last indulgence to remove the default to restore the case.
