1. Challenge in this petition is that though the petitioners were initially appointed as Shiksha Karmi Grade-III and have subsequently been absorbed to the Education Department, they have by now completed 10 years of service and therefore they are entitled for the benefit of *Karmonnati* as per rules governing the field, however, the respondents till date have not granted the said benefit to the petitioners.
2. Given the limited grievance which the petitioners have raised, let the petitioners make a suitable representation to the respondents No.3 & 4 within a period of three weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and the respondents No.3 & 4, in turn, shall take a decision on the granting of *Kramonnati* to the petitioners within a further period of 90 days.
3. The writ petition accordingly stands disposed of.
