PER COURT : (Operative Order)

1. In Criminal Application No. 7209 of 2017, relief of quashing of F.I.R. No.96 of 2017 registered in Mohadi Police Station, for the offences punishable under Sections 306, 323, 504, 506 read with Sec.34 of the Indian Penal Code is granted and to that extent, the F.I.R. is quashed and set aside.
