PER COURT :

1. We are not going to entertain such a petition. The appellate order was passed in August, 2019. The petitioner for the first time, has filed revision on 17th February, 2020 and within eight days filed the present writ petition seeking direction to decide the revision. The petitioner took more than five months to file a revision and now within eight days, wants direction to decide the revision within one month.
