3. In light of the above, the impugned order is quashed and set aside. The respondents shall not take any action pursuant to the impugned order without issuing notice to the petitioner and without hearing of the petitioner.

4. The writ petition is accordingly disposed of. No costs.

5. The committee may endeavor to decide the proceedings expeditiously.
