1] The applicant has moved this application seeking order to restrain the respondent nos.1 to 4 from withdrawing the amount of compensation payable towards acquisition of land under the provisions of the National Highways Act.

2] Mr.Rathi, learned counsel submits that though office has raised objection, he has filed *Vakalatnama*. Registry to check whether *Vakalatnama* is filed. In case *Vakalatnama* is not filed, learned counsel is directed to file fresh *Vakalatnama*.

3] Learned counsel for the applicant submits that though the applicant has moved this application to restrain respondent nos.1 to 4 to withdraw amount now it is learnt that they have already withdrawn the amount. In that view, no cause survives to prosecute the application. Accordingly, application is disposed of as infructuous.
