1. I have heard learned counsel for the applicant for some time. Learned counsel for the applicant, on instructions, seeks leave to withdraw this application. Learned counsel however submits that the applicant is suffering from CVA with left Hemiparesis and the medical certificates to that effect are also available. Learned counsel submits that the applicant has not raised those health grounds before the Sessions Court, nor before this Court in his application. Learned counsel thus seeks liberty to the applicant to file an application before the Sessions Court for bail on his health grounds.

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2. Leave granted. The application is disposed off as withdrawn. The applicant is at liberty to file an application for regular bail before the Sessions Court on health grounds, if any, and upon filing of such application, it is for the court below to consider the same on its own merits.
