1. I have heard the learned counsel for the petitioner for some time.

2. The learned counsel for the petitioner, on instructions, seeks leave to withdraw this writ petition. The learned counsel for the petitioner, however, submits that the petitioner, if availed alternate remedy of filing the appeal before the S.D.O., the S.D.O. should not pass any order under the influence of the directions given by the Collector. The petitioner aggrieved by the order passed by the Tahsildar, if approaches the S.D.O. by filing an appeal, it is for the S.D.O. to decide the said appeal, on its own merits, without getting influenced by any directions on administrative side by the Collector. Leave granted. Writ petition disposed of as withdrawn.
