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ORAL ORDER :

1. The appellant and respondent No. 1 are present with their respective Advocate and submits that the parties have settled the dispute. Consent terms filed taken on record and marked as 'X' for identification. The report of verification and identification of the parties submitted by Registrar [Judicial] is taken on record and marked as 'Y' for identification.

2. The parties present in person admit their respective signature and further confirmed the terms of settlement to be recorded truly and correctly as per the settlement reached between the parties.
