1 Heard both sides.

2 It appears that the date of award is 12th February, 2016. The S.L.A.O. has awarded compensation @ Rs.58,500/- per hectare, whereas the Civil Court has granted enhanced compensation @ Rs.5332/- per Are for Bagayat land.

3 Thus, considering the same, the applicant-original claimant in this civil application is permitted to withdraw the compensation amount partly with certain

conditions. Hence, the following order:-

ORDER

- I. The civil application is partly allowed.
- II. The applicant-original claimant is permitted to withdraw the compensation amount to the extent of 50% out of the amount deposited before this Court on furnishing an undertaking and further 25% of the amount out of the amount deposited before this Court on furnishing solvent security/surety to the satisfaction of Registrar (Judicial) of this Court.
- III. Civil application is accordingly disposed of.
