ORAL ORDER :

1. Heard learned A.G.P. for applicants/State.
2. Learned A.G.P. submits that the amount to be deposited in terms of conditional order dated 13/09/2019 could not be deposited within stipulated period provided in the order due to out burst of Corona Virus and receipt of funds from State Govt.
