PER COURT :

. The learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the vehicle has been seized under panchanama. However, no order has been passed, no penalty has been imposed. As no order is passed, the petitioners are not in a position to file an appeal. The vehicle of the petitioners is detained since September, 2020. The petitioners have approached the Tahsildar, Sub-Divisional Officer and the Collector for release of their vehicles, but in vain.

2. The Sub-Divisional Officer shall take decision upon the application of the petitioners. The petitioners shall file afresh application with the concerned Sub-Divisional Officer for release

of their vehicles. The Sub-Divisional Officer shall decide the said application preferably within two weeks on its own merit.

3. Writ petition is disposed of. No costs.
