2 Heard both the sides.

3 It has been stated in para 4 of the common order dated 29th September, 2020, passed by this Court in I this group of Writ Petitions, that:

“4 In view of above submission and since the parties have arrived at amicable settlement in terms of lump-sum payment as per the compromise memo, all writ petitions are disposed of. No costs.”

4 However, it appears that, inadvertently, it is not mentioned in para 4 of the aforesaid common order dated 29th

September, 2020, that the petitioner, in all these writ petitions, is permitted to withdraw the lump-sum payment in terms of clause (C) of the compromise.

5 Hence, para 4 of the common order dated 29th September, 2020, passed by this Court in this group of writ petitions, be substituted and read as follows:

That the petitioner, in all these writ petitions, is permitted to withdraw the lump-sum payment in terms of clause (C) of the Compromise. No costs.”
