PER COURT :

1] The applicants – appellants have moved these applications seeking condonation of 487 days delay in filing appeals.

2] Heard learned counsel for the applicants and respondents.

3] On due consideration of the submissions advanced in the light of facts pleaded in the applications assigning the cause for condonation of delay, I am of the view that the delay deserves to be condoned as pleadings made in that behalf remained unchallenged and uncontroverted.
