OPERATIVE ORDER :

(i) The Criminal Writ Petition is allowed to the extent of prayer clause in which compensation is claimed. The total compensation of Rs. 5,00,000/- is awarded. The amount is to be deposited initially by the State Government and it is to be deposited within a period of 45 days from the date of this order in the Court. If the amount is not deposited within a period of 45 days, it will carry interest @ 8% per annum.

(ii) After depositing amount in the Court, the amount is to be handed over equally to the parent of the deceased.

- (iii) It will be open to the State Government to fasten the liability on the respondents mentioning the decision and recover that amount from them.
- (iv) Rule is made absolute in those terms.
- (v) Other prayers can be considered by the trial court.
- (vi) Reasons to follow.
