REGISTRAR'S ORDER

The admit notice of respondent returned unserved. As per the bailiff report dated 06.11.2019, the notice to respondent could not be served, as nobody could tell the correct address in the locality. The Ld. Advocate for the applicant to pay the necessary process fees, collect the publication notice. After publishing it Advocate shall file the affidavit of service along with the newspaper. Accordingly, the Misc. Civil Appln. is disposed of.
