2. The issue raised in this petition concerns the confirmation
of the Petitioner to the post of Deputy Director of Fire and
Emergency Services.

4. Mr. D. Lawande, learned counsel for Respondent No.5 makes a statement that the GPSC, will dispose of such proposal within a period of four weeks from the date of its receipt, provided of course if the complete proposal is received by the GPSC.

5. We expect the State to forward a complete proposal to the GPSC within a period of four weeks from today so that, the GPSC will be in a position to take appropriate decision within a period of four weeks thereafter.
