. These three petitions concern reliefs to be granted to the respective respondent employees by the Petitioner establishment in Writ Petition Nos.4961 of 2014, 4963 of 2014 and 5568 of 2017. The fourth petition, Writ Petition No.632 of 2018, has been filed by an employee against the establishment. Learned Counsel for the parties, after taking instructions from their respective clients, propose minutes of order.
