. The substantive prayer in this writ petition is prayer clause (c) seeking appointment of new Chief Administrator in view of the demise of the learned erstwhile administrator. The petitioners seek further

directions for appointment of new Administrator by this Court in the Writ Petition No.6831 of 1998.
