The oral exchange mentioned in paragraph 4 of communication dated 16th June, 2014 addressed to Police Commissioner and other officers in their names pertain to a grievance contained in complaint dated 26th March, 2014. That grievance has been looked into as civil grievance. Petitioner is not questioning this determination. Petitioner has already filed civil suit accordingly.

2. Submission is the oral exchange mentioned in paragraph 4 of communication dated 16th June, 2014 discloses another offence. As the main offence which according to petitioner gives rise to that oral

exchange is itself found to be of civil nature. We find it not necessary to examine said contention after 5 years in extra-ordinary jurisdiction. Petition is, therefore, rejected.
