1. Withdrawal pursis was tendered before the previous Lok Adalat. The authorized officer for the State and the authorized officer of the acquiring body are present. They have put signatures on the withdrawal pursis before us.

2. Shri Ajay Pawar, the Deputy Collector/SLAO, Pune for appellant has filed withdrawal pursis seeking leave to withdraw the appeal. Shri Ajay Pawar, Deputy Collector submits that the State does not desire to proceed with the appeal and intends to withdraw the appeal. He admits the contents of the withdrawal pursis and his signature thereon. The withdrawal pursis also bears the signatures of

Ms. V.S. Suryawanshi, Deputy Engineer of the acquiring body and Shri A.R. Patil, the learned Addl. G.P. for the State.

3. The withdrawal pursis is taken on record and marked 'A' for identification.

4. In view of the withdrawal pursis, the appeal stands disposed of as withdrawn.

5. Court fee refund be made as per rules.

6. In view of withdrawal of appeal, pending application, if any, also stands disposed of.

7. In view of withdrawal of the appeal, the original claimant-respondent or his legal representatives, in the event the original claimant/respondent is dead, shall be entitled to the amount deposited in the reference Court in terms of the award impugned herein.

8. In the event the original claimant/respondent is dead, the reference Court shall permit the legal representatives to bring them on record on the basis of an application supported by an affidavit, and, thereafter, pass appropriate order to release the amount deposited in the Court, in accordance with law.
