- 1] Prisoner through communication dated 1st September 2018 seeks quashing of FIR.
- 2] FIR is under sections 353, 323, 504 and 506 of IPC. The chargeheet is filed on 23rd February 2017 and the Trial Court has now issued bailable warrant against the prisoner on 19th July 2019 and it is returnable on 27th February 2020.
- 3] It is apparent that the cognizance of prayer as made cannot be taken because contention is of vindictive attitude, since previous demand was not satisfied, offence has been registered.
- 4] We find prayer unsustainable. Hence, petition is rejected.
