Learned AGP, on instructions, states upon the Petitioner depositing a sum of Rs.6,474/- with the District Re-Settlement Officer, the District Re-Settlement Officer shall take a decision on the application of the Petitioner for allotment of alternate land within a period of four weeks from the date of deposit.

2. Accepting the statement of the learned AGP, we dispose of the Contempt Petition.

3. We make it clear that in the event the decision is not taken by the District Re-Settlement Officer, the Petitioner would be entitled to file a Contempt Petition alleging aggravated contempt.
