1. The only prayer in this petition is for expediting the hearing and disposal of Marriage Petition No. 280 of 2016, pending before the Family Court at Thane. The learned counsel for the Petitioner has produced affidavit of service on the Respondent. However, none appears for the Respondent. There is no adverse order, which is being sought, or is being passed in the present petition. Section 21 of the Hindu Marriage Act mandates disposal of the marriage petition as far as practicable within a period of six months.
