1. It is alleged that the applicant was in relationship with accused no.1, a married person. It is alleged on 31st January, 2019, accused no.1 caused death of his wife and minor daughter inflicting incised wounds by sharp weapon and burnt their bodies in an attempt to disappear the evidence. Evidence, on record in the form of CCTV footage, prima-facie shows

presence of the applicant on the spot of the incident. Besides, report of Director, Fingerprint Bureau, CID, Mumbai in respect of two chance Foot (Sole) prints shows :

*"Two chance Foot (Sole) prints developed on the "Bedroom Flooring Tiles" concerned in Shahunagar Police Station, C.R. No. 30/2019 U/s 302, 201, 120(B) IPC, both are **"IDENTICAL"** with '**Right Foot Print Portion & Left Foot Print Portion**' respectively on the Foot impression slips of '**Amrin Fayyaj Sayyad** (Applicant) (**Suspect**)' received for comparison under letter no. quoted above."*

2. In view of the CCTV footage, report of Fingerprint Bureau and the call detail records, *prima-facie*, discloses applicant's complicity in the offence. The offence is punishable with life or death. In view of the evidence and the facts of the case, the Bail Application is rejected.
