1 Heard. By this Writ Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, the Petitioner seeks to set aside the certificate dated 10.07.2019 in Application Nos.1040/2018-19, 1041/2018-19 and 1042/2018-19 granted by the Learned Dy. Registrar u/s.101 of the Maharashtra Cooperative Societies Act, 1960 for recovery of the loan amount from the guarantor.

2 The learned counsel for Respondent Nos.3 and 4 submits that alternate efficacious remedy is available to the Petitioner to challenge the said certificate. Hence, there is no question of entertaining the Writ Petition.

3      Considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for Respondent Nos.3 and 4 and as the alternate efficacious remedy is available to the Petitioner, we do not find any reason to entertain the Writ Petition.

4      Hence, the Writ Petition stands rejected with liberty to the Petitioner to challenge the said proceedings before the appropriate authority.

5      All contentions of the parties are kept open.
