Heard learned Company Prosecutor and have perused the averments made in the Official Liquidator's Report. The Registrar of Companies has already forwarded its 'No Objection Certificate' vide letter dated 27th December, 2017 which has been approved by the Office of the Official Liquidator. The Income Tax Department has also issued 'No Objection Certificate'. The voluntary liquidator and the ex-directors have also submitted affidavit stating that there is no outstanding dues to any Government Department and no prosecution pending against the company in liquidation. It is stated in the report that the affairs of the company do not otherwise seem to have been conducted in a manner prejudicial to the interest of its members or to the public interest and thus company in liquidation would be treated as dissolved from the date of submission of the report in terms of the provisions of section 497(6) of the Companies Act, 1956.
