1. The petition is under Section 29-A of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act 1996. There were disputes between the parties in regard to a loan agreement dated 30th November 2015. A sole arbitrator was appointed by consent. He entered upon the reference to his arbitration on 25th July 2018 and the matter then proceeded before him.
