2 After arguing for some time, Advocate for the Petitioner and Advocate for the Respondent Nos. 3 and 4 tendered Minutes of Order dated 03.02.2020. Same is taken on record and marked "X" for identification, which reads thus:

"MINUTES OF ORDER

4) By consent, the Writ Petition is disposed off in terms of the Minutes of Order.
