1. The petition is under Section 29-A of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act 1996.

2. Disputes arose between the parties under an Agreement. This Court appointed the Sole Arbitrator was appointed by an Order dated 28th February 2018. The Sole Arbitrator entered upon the reference to its arbitration shortly thereafter, and the matter proceeded before it.
