In pursuance of the order dated 17 February 2020 passed by this court, the learned Additional Registrar (Original Side)/Additional Prothonotary and Senior Master, has placed on record his report dated 24 February 2020 stating out that there is a compliance of Rule 260 of the Rules and Form of High Court Judicature at Bombay(Original Side).
