- 2.** This appeal under Section 260A of the Income Tax Act, 1961 ("**the Act**" for short) is preferred by the revenue against the order dated 7.9.2016 passed by the Income Tax Appellate Tribunal, Mumbai "H" Bench, Mumbai ("**Tribunal**" for short) in Income Tax Appeal No. 3512/Mum/2014 for the assessment year 2002-03.
- 3.** Mr. Chhotaray, learned standing counsel, revenue for

the appellant fairly submits that the disputed tax effect in this appeal is Rs. 51,29,096.00 which is below the enhanced prescribed limit for filing of appeal before the High Court in terms of CBDT Circular No. 17/2019 dated 8.8.2019.
