The Petitioner seeks a Legal Heirship Certificate under Section 2 of Bombay Regulation VIII of 1827 in respect of one Ankush Sakharam Jadhav, who is said to have died intestate in Satara, being ordinarily resident in Mumbai, on 5th September 2004. A copy of his death certificate is annexed. The deceased was survived by his two sisters and two brothers. Their names are mentioned in the tabulation below paragraph 4 of the petition.

2. The Legal Heirship Certificate is required for the purpose of transferring one of the properties of the deceased.
