This is an application for intervention filed on behalf of the applicant primarily on the ground that even in the proceeding in which the impugned order was passed, he was a party and yet, he has not been made a party in the present writ petition.

2. In addition, the learned counsel for the applicant has invited attention of this Court to order dated 04/11/2019, passed by this Court in Writ Petition No.6555/2019. The said order concerns an issue raised by the applicant before this Court with regard to the necessity of the applicant being heard in the proceedings before the Minister under the proceedings of the Maharashtra Village Panchayat Act, 1958.
