This is State Appeal challenging the order of acquittal passed in Summary Criminal Case No.290/2014, thereby and under which the trial Court acquitted the sole accused for the offence punishable under Sections 279, 304-A of the Indian Penal Code and Section 3 read with Sections 181 and 184 of the Motor Vehicles Act.
