By order dated 31st August 2020 this Court directed issuance of bailable warrant against the respondent-accused to secure his presence before this Court. Today, the office note shows that the report of execution of the bailable warrant is awaited.

When the matter was called-out in the morning session, the learned A.P.P. was asked to take instructions. Now, when the matter is called-out in the afternoon session, the learned A.P.P. informed that as per the report sent by the Sessions Court, the sole respondent-accused-Khemraj Bhasu Pawar is reported to be dead. A copy of Death Certificate is also placed on record showing that the sole respondent-Khemraj Bhasu Pawar died on 27th January 2008. Legal Representatives of the respondent-accused have not taken any steps to come on record.

In the above facts, nothing survives in the appeal as it stands abated.

The criminal appeal is **dismissed** accordingly.
