1. These two applications arise out of Crime No.37/2018 registered with Police Station Civil Lines, Akola for offences punishable under Section 498-A read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code on complaint lodged by non-applicant No.2-Deepali Yogesh Lakhade.

2. In both these applications, applicants are represented by learned counsel Shri S.D.Khati. The State has filed affidavit in Criminal Application (APL) No.443/2018. In the said reply affidavit, it has been stated that after completion of entire investigation, chargesheet is

already filed. The reply is filed on 4.5.2018.

3. In view of filing of chargesheet, learned counsel Shri S.D.Khati for applicants submits that he has instructions from applicants in these two applications to withdraw these applications since they wish to file an application for discharge before Trial court.
