2. The applicants, who are arrested on 13.10.2020 for the offence punishable under Sections 326, 325, 324, 452, 143, 147, 149 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code in Crime No. 257 of 2020 by the Dahihanda Police Station, Tq. and District – Akola, have moved this application.

3. There are counter cases against the applicants and the complainants out of the single incident. In the present crime, 17 to 18 accused have been involved. The incident is the outcome of the

old rivalry between the two families. The weapons used are steel pipes and wooden sticks.

4. It is stated that the informant and his co-accused are being prosecuted for the offence under Section 307 of the Indian Penal Code. The injured, who received injuries at the hands of the present applicants, have been discharged from the hospital on the very same day. The prosecution could not point out criminal antecedents against the present applicants.

5. Considering the aforesaid facts, the case for bail is made out. Hence, the following order :

6. Criminal application is allowed on the following conditions :

(i) On the applicants executing Personal Bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rs. Twenty thousand only) each with one surety each in the like amount.

(ii) The applicants shall not indulge again in such offences.

(iii) The applicants shall not issue threats or tamper with the prosecution witnesses.

(iv) The applicants shall attend Police Station once in a month on every first Thursday of the month.

7. Needless to mention that the observations made in this application are strictly for deciding the present application of the applicants and the trial Court shall be free to decide the matter on its merits.
