under.

Nomadic Tribe (B) category, is pending for
the decision by the Scrutiny Committee,
however, the college is taking adverse
action against the petitioner.*

*Issue notice for final disposal of the
matter, to the respondents, returnable on

*By way of adinterim order, the
admission of the petitioner shall stand
protected. The petitioner shall be
permitted to appear in the examination
