3.The learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent submitted that initially a case was registered by the respondent and after investigation, he filed 'Further Action Dropped' report on 01.03.2019 before the learned IX Metropolitan Magistrate, Saidapet.

4.In view of the above, nothing survives for adjudicating the petition and hence, the same is dismissed. Consequently, the connected miscellaneous petition is closed.

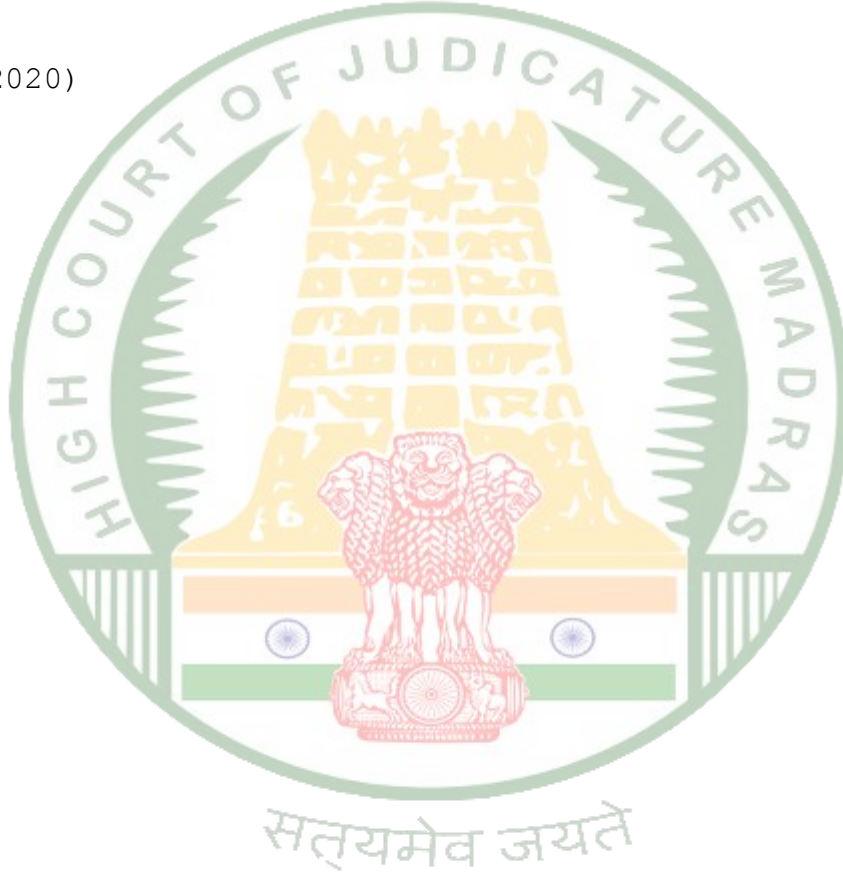
