C O M M O N O R D E R

On 28.07.2020, when the matter was called, there was no representation on behalf of the petitioners and hence, the matter was directed to be listed on 06.08.2020. When the matter was listed on 06.08.2020, there was no representation on behalf of the petitioners and hence, in order to give one more opportunity to the petitioners to argue the case, the matter was directed to be listed on 07.08.2020 under the caption 'For Dismissal'. Even today (i.e. on 07.08.2020), when the matter is called, there is no representation on behalf of the petitioners. Hence these writ petitions are dismissed for non-prosecution.

Incidentally, the learned Special Government Pleader representing the first respondent submitted that the petitioners have sent letters dated 03.08.2020 addressed to the Inspector of Police, Vaththalagundu Police Station, Dindigul District, written by all the three petitioners in the above three writ petitions mentioning that the matter has been amicably settled between them and the private respondents herein. In response, on behalf of private respondents, namely respondents 2 to 4, one Mary Thomas (respondent No.4), has addressed a similar letter to the Inspector of Police, Vaththalagundu Police Station, Dindigul District. The learned Special Government Pleader is directed to send a copy of the said letters to the Registry for keeping them in the bundle.

3. In view of the above, the writ petitions are dismissed. However, there shall be no order as to cost.
