JUDGMENT

Suit Valuation Act, 1955.

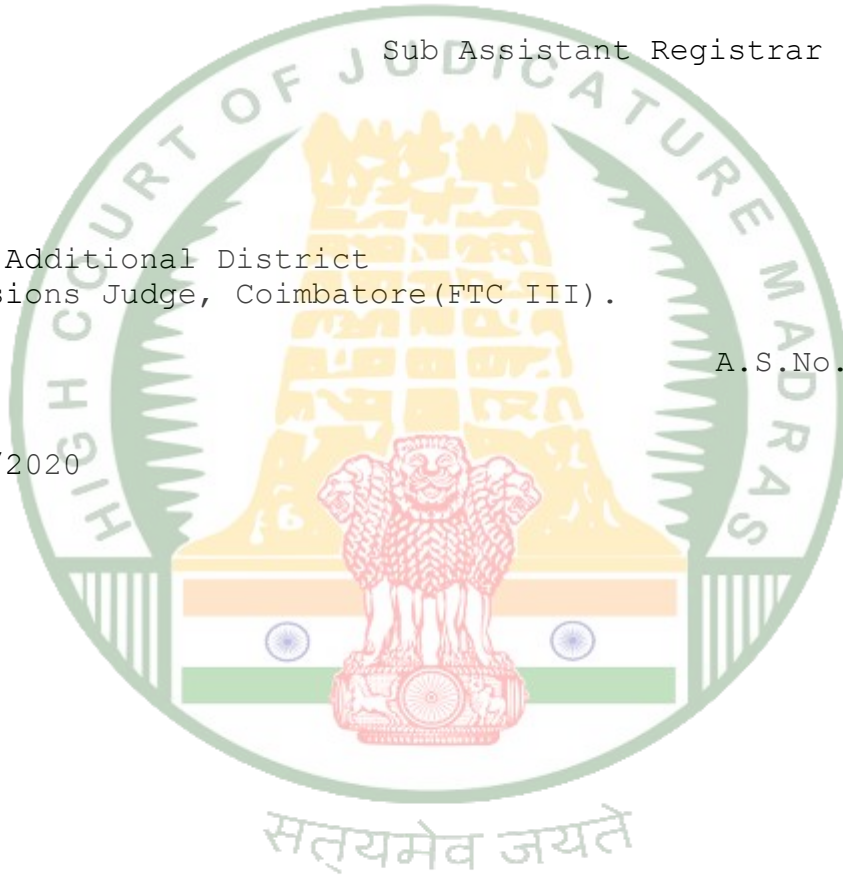
