JUDGMENT

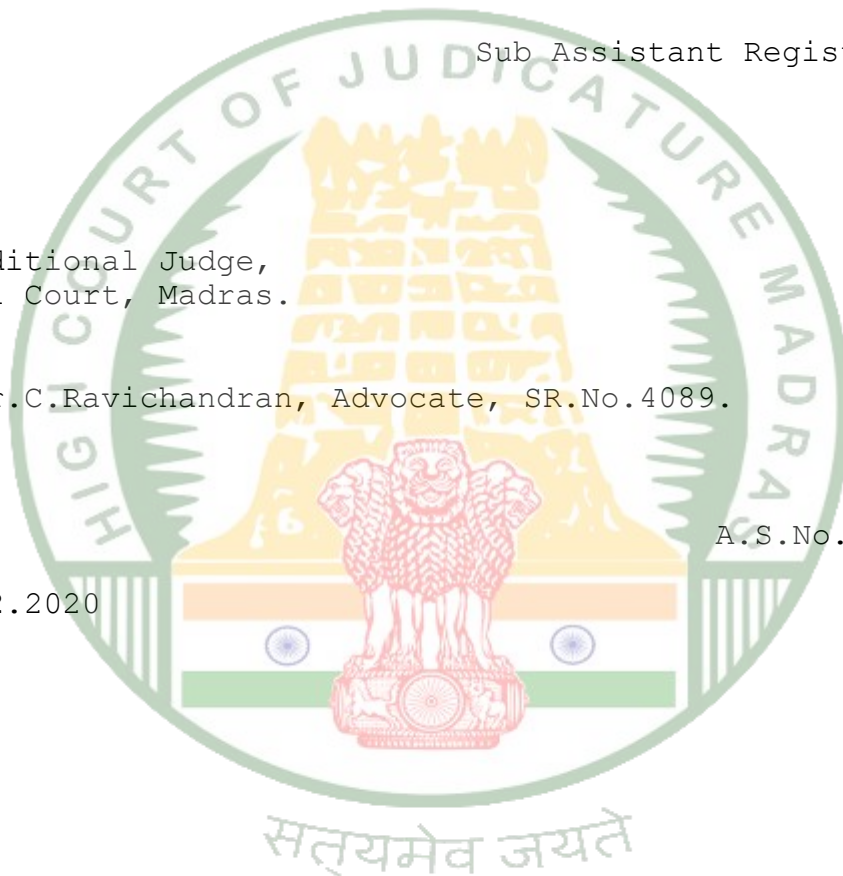
