appearing for the first respondent and the learned counsel appearing for the second respondent and also perused the records.

Learned Additional Public Prosecutor submits that the case in Crime No.02 of 2015, which is under challenge in this petition, on completion of investigation, had culminated into C.C.No.2772 of 2016 and after full pledged trial, the learned Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, Egmore, Chennai, had acquitted all the three accused/petitioners herein on 28.06.2019.
