Prayer: Civil Suit has been filed under Order VII, Rule 1 of C.P.C read with Order IV, Rule 1 of O.S. Rules, praying to pass a judgment and decree jointly and severally against the defendants: (a) for a permanent injunction restraining the 1st defendant from manufacturing of the products identical to that of the products of the plaintiff vi., (i) Trip Circuit supervision Relay-Type VAX MK II and (ii) Tipping Relay-Type VAJ; (b) directing the 1st defendant to withdraw such offending products from the market immediately; (c) damages for loss of reputation and business to the tune of Rs.1,00,00,000/- (Rupees one crore only); and (d) for costs of the suit.

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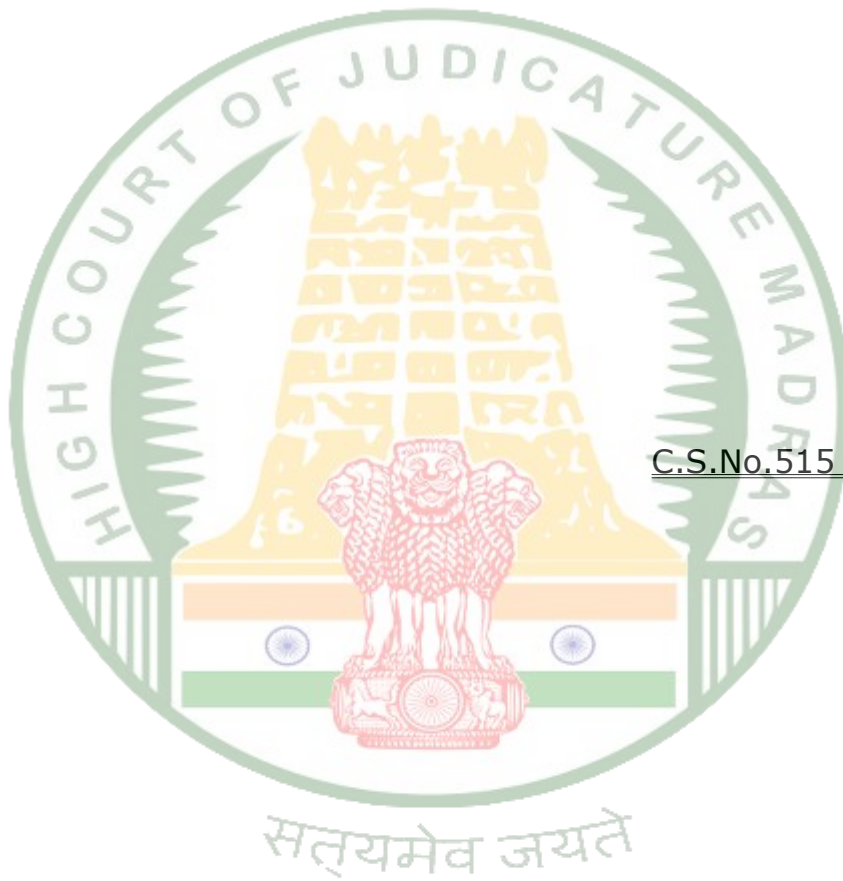
