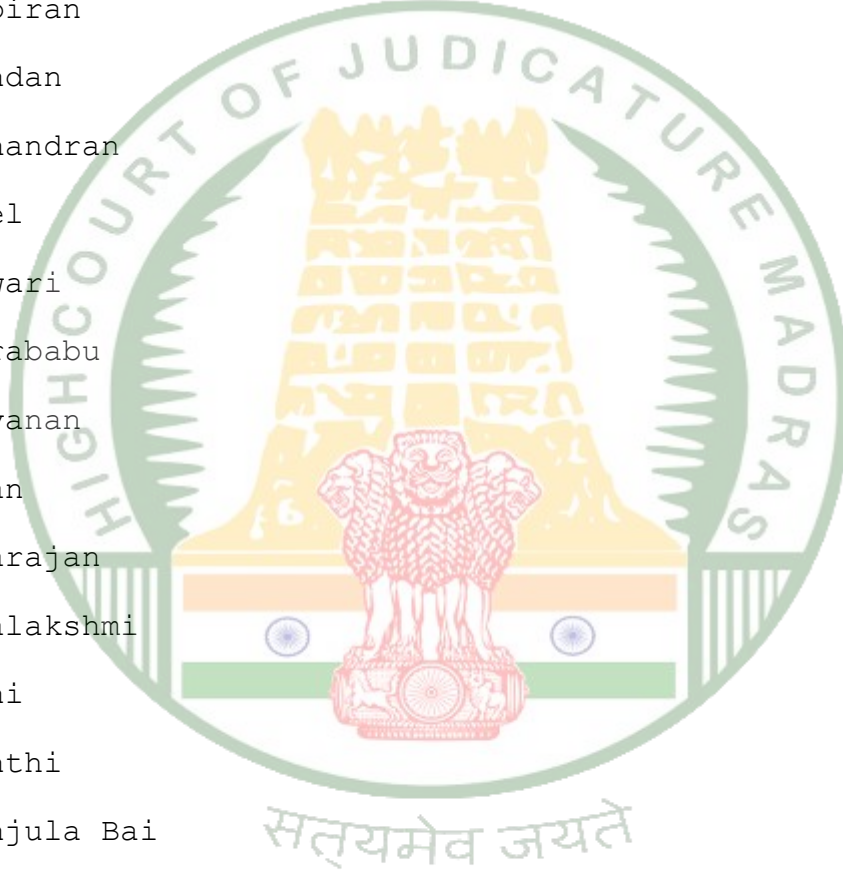

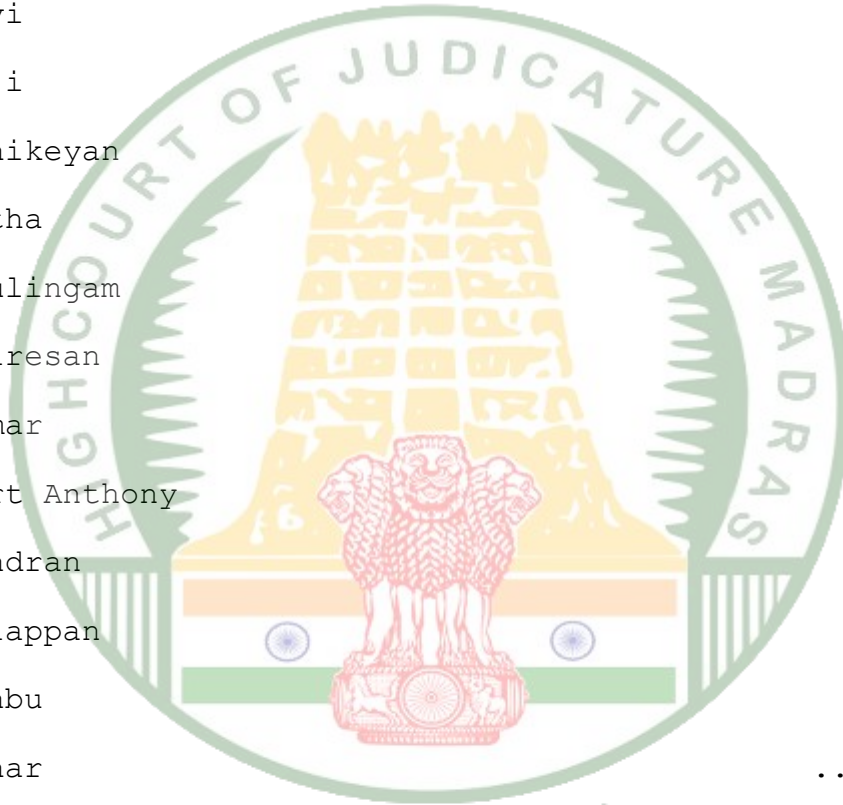

When the matter was taken up for hearing on 16.10.2020 and 27.11.2020, there was no representation for the petitioners. 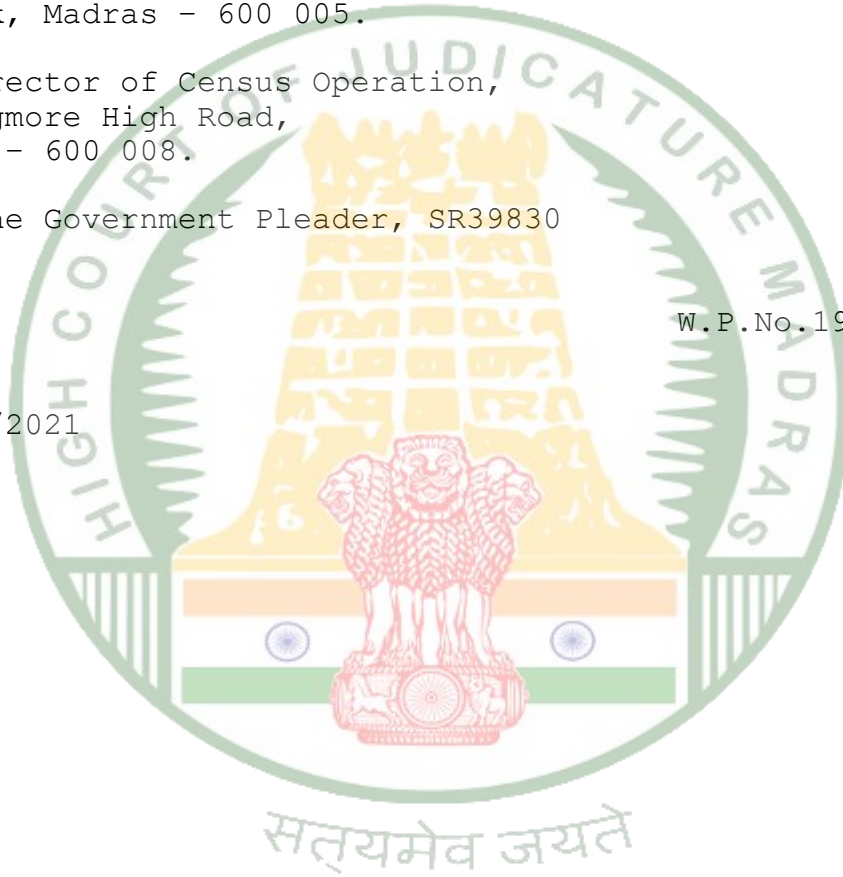
