PRAYER :

Originally this petition has been filed as Original Application No.2647 of 2003 before the Tamil Nadu Administrative Tribunal at Chennai and after abolition of TNAT, application has been transferred and numbered as W.P.No.16794 of 2007.

Writ petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying for the issuance of a Writ of Certiorarified Mandamus to call for the records relating to the proceedings of the second respondent dated 30.09.2002 in Na.Ka.No.139295/W26/92, quash the same and consequently for a direction, directing the respondents to regularize the service of the petitioner as vocational instructor Grade I with effect from 23.09.1994 and give all the concomitant monetary and other service benefits on par with other vocational instructors Grade I.
